Fellowship Policy

1. Applications are invited for Indian Academy of Science and Technology Society Fellowship (FIASc) available for applicants from all parts of India. This a fellowship for individuals only and does not fund enrollment for degree or non degree study at academic institutions, including dissertation research etc.
2. **Eligibility :**
 - (i) Applicants should possess a deep understanding of their chosen subject and a track record of professional accomplishment.
 - (ii) There are no age restrictions.
 - (iii) At least one letter of recommendation.
 - (iv) Candidates must be life member of society.
3. **Application Process** – Applicants are required to submit a one or two page, single spaced letter of inquiry that outlines the topic of the project, proposed work product, and relevance to the statements above. A curriculum Vita (CV) should accompany the letter of inquiry.

Selection Process :

An interdisciplinary selection committee will review application in consultation with the potential host unit(s) of the candidate. Faculty reviewers will evaluate candidates based on :

- Innovative and focused research proposal, teaching statement.
- Inter disciplinary strengths of applicants work.

- Ability of the applicant to contribute to diversity, equity and inclusion efforts in higher education through their research teaching service and lived experiences.

Fields of Fellowship :

Applicants are invited from suitably qualified, scientist, faculty, research scholar and students in any field of the life sciences, engineering technology health and management.

Strongly Desirable Subfields :

Biological Sciences, Health and Medical, Biotechnology, Electrical Engineering, Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Ecology, Evolution, Molecular Biology, and Mathematics.

Desirable Subfields :

Agriculture, Earth & Environment, Medicine, Paramedical, Pharmaceutical Science, Forestry, Fisheries & Human Welfare.
